## Required documents

The following documents should be attached to the application form:

- A certified copy of your diploma and final grades** (signed and stamped by the appropriate authority such as your school).  
If you still need to sit your final exams, you can send us your grade lists over the past years.  
Note that for final enrolment you still have to send or show us the certified copy as soon as you pass your exams.
  - Certified copies of your birth certificate and its English translation (certified translator)**
  - A copy of your (*valid*) **passport**
  - A Nuffic certificate : [www.nuffic.nl](http://www.nuffic.nl) (only for Chinese students)
  - Five passport-size photos** (4.5cm x 3.5cm). The photo should have a white or light grey background.
  - Résumé/Curriculum Vitae** (in English). Not needed for Pre-Bachelor students.
  - Students who already live in the Netherlands** also have to send a copy of a valid residence permit which proves they are entitled to stay in the Netherlands, a copy of address registration in the Netherlands (GBA form or copy of your housing contract) and a statement concerning all previous education since arrival in the Netherlands. Please enclose your transcript and send a proof of enrolment of the school you are studying at this moment.
  
  - Sufficient IELTS/TOEFL IBT** (for the programme you apply for).  
Not required for students who have completed an English-taught (accredited) Bachelor programme.  
**IELTS:** International English Language Testing System - Organised by British Council - [www.ielts.org](http://www.ielts.org)  
The IELTS test, Academic Band, consists of 4 parts: writing, reading, listening and speaking.  
Subscores can not be lower than 0.5 points (from the overall band score).  
**TOEFL:** Test of English as a Foreign Language - Organised by the ETS in the USA - [www.toefl.org](http://www.toefl.org)  
The institution code for the Rotterdam Business School is 7140.  
Students are also allowed to submit a TOEFL Paper score or TOEFL Computer. Except for Chinese students.

NVAO - is the Accreditation Organization of the Netherlands and Flanders (Belgium).
- Personal Development Statement; please write a short essay, covering 600-800 words.  
Subjects to be discussed: short autobiography; what do you consider your most significant achievement to date;  
How do you expect the Master programme will contribute to your development.
